Medal for the Best First Time Entrant

The Sequences with the above awards will be presented at BIAF International Film, Video & AV

Festival on Friday 8th April 2011 at The Cairn Hotel, Harrogate.

The judges, at their discretion, may award other certificates of merit for outstanding work.

There will be an Award for the top Sequence selected by the Audience.

2. SUBJECTS - The choice of subject is entirely free. There will be no separate categories

No sequence may exceed 12 minutes

3. AUTHORSHIP - Sequence production must be the original work of the entrant, co-author(s)

and collaborators. There is no limit on the number of co-authors. Up to two Sequences per entrant. Authors may be mentioned in other Sequences. There is no limit on the date of creation, but sequences must not have been shown in any previous Geoffrey Round Competition.

- 4. ENTRY FORMS** - Every entry requires a separate entry form and fee of £10 (or 10 Euro cash) for 1 entry or £15 (or 15 Euro cash) for 2 entries. Cheques made payable to “North Wales & Wirral Audio Visual Group”.
- 5. CLOSING DATE** - All entry forms, fees and sequence material must reach:

by the closing date of February 7th 2011.
- 6. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS** - All Entries must be Stand-alone Digital Productions such as Pictures to EXE and supplied on a CD (no need for separate disks) ready for transfer to Hard Disk. Under exceptional circumstances and by prior arrangement, Sequences may be sent via www.yousendit.com to mewaine@chasingthelight.co.uk
- 7. COPYRIGHT** – Submission of an entry implies that the entrant has obtained any necessary licences or permission to use any copyright material included in the sequence. Please give any licence details on the entry form. Submission of entry implies the granting of permission by the author for the sequence to be shown in public.
- 8 SUMMARIES** - Sequences with text should be accompanied by a clear and concise summary, maximum of twelve lines. (Written in English would be helpful to the organisers).
- 9. ENTRIES** - Submission of an entry implies that the entrant has read and accepted the rules in all respects. While every care will be taken in handling entries, the organisers cannot accept responsibility for any loss or damage, however caused. Please Note, CD's will not be returned unless requested and postage/packaging provided.
